What is a Certified Nurse Aide (CNA)?

CNAs give hands-on care to patients in hospitals, nursing homes or other facilities, under the guidance of an LPN or RN. A CNA must complete an approved CNA course, be 16 years of age, physically able to perform the duties required, have no felony convictions and pass the Kansas CNA state test. A CNA will work to provide basic nursing care procedures to include:

Personal hygiene: (bath, hair, nail care, toilet, etc.)

- Patient Meals: Patient feeding responsibilities.
- Vital signs: Blood pressure, pulse, and temperature monitoring.
- Social and emotional support.
- Maintain patient records.
- Assisting with activities and exercise.
