

Several Southeast students ride in area rodeos, and on Saturday March 26, the All Youth Rodeo Association came to Columbus. Southeast sixth grader Quintonn Lunsford's winning ride from the Columbus rodeo was even shown on KOAM TV. Whether it's riding a makeshift mechanical bull or watching videos, Quintonn and fifth grader Eli Pritchett said it's a lot of work, but a lot of fun.

"I watch my videos over and over-like, last week, I about fell off coming out of the chute but I had to pull myself back on so I watched my video over like five times to see how I did it," Quintonn said. "The energy starts flowing, makes you want to stay on there—you get all pumped up behind the chutes.'

Even with the hard work, sometimes you get thrown and have to get right back on again. At the Columbus rodeo, Eli was thrown.

"You have to have a lot of confidence." Eli said. "I got thrown onto the dashboard-the front of the horse. My rear came off the saddle, I couldn't get back down and I went over the front of the horse."

For both boys, it was their families that got them into rodeo. Eli thinks he started riding when he was four years old; Quintonn thinks he was four.

Both boys say it's the thrill of the ride and the roar of the crowd that keeps bringing them back, and they'd like to see more kids try it, saying it's a lot more fun than sitting inside and playing video games.
