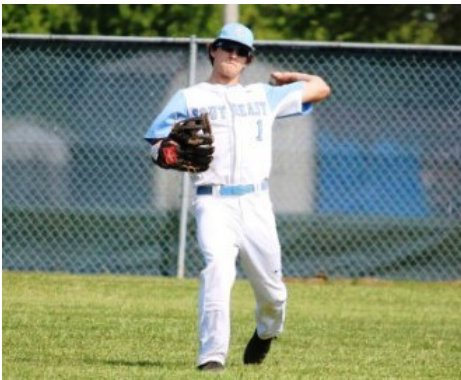

SE State Track & Field results; Girls 3200 M school record broken



Class of 2016 member Sam Holsinger played a round of pool at the student center on the Wichita State campus. Storms forced multiple delays during Friday's State Track meet. Eventually, many of Friday's events were postponed to Saturday May 29, including all events that SE student-athletes were competing in. SE results in Class 3A at State:

- Kalyn Bitner took 12th in Girls Shotput with a throw of 34'5.5".
- Mireesa Gordon tied for 14th by clearing 4'8" in the Girls High Jump; and, was 16th in the Girls Triple Jump with a jump of 29'7".
- Sam Holsinger scratched in all four attempts in the Boys Discus to finish 16th.
- Jessie Jenkins took 12th in the Girls 3200 Meter Run with a run of 12:48.46, beating her own school record; and, took 13th in the Girls 1600 Meter Run with a run of 6:03.17.
- Saydie Sullivan took 15th in the Girls 300 Meter Intermediate Hurdles with a run of 55.01.
- Jacob Wyckoff took 14th in the Boys 800 Meter Run with a run of 12:15.13
