Packing for "Pioneer Days"

Southeast 4th graders are playing a their own version of the computer game "Oregon Trail", but instead of a computer doing the work for them as they go along, the students are doing it. Mrs. Joyce Fox explained, for a while, Oregon Trail wasn't available, so she created her own pencil and paper game. Plus, she said, this way, students learn how to apply math and reading skills to the real world.

The eight or nine students in each of the three teams drew a role, such as banker, blacksmith, doctor or farmer, then each team decided between a smaller wagon or larger one, and between using horses or oxen. Each combination has its own advantages and disadvantages. Using oxen allows you to carry more but you will go slower. Then each team worked together to decide what supplies to pack, while staying under their allowed budget, especially since they can't make money along the way.

"They're having to take a real world situation, like deciding how much food you want," said Mrs. Fox. "If I only have this much budgeted for it, what's going to happen? Some of them will probably starve to death, like one group only took 72 pounds of food. Every day you go without food your strength goes down. It's learning to work together in their groups. They'll hunt and every time they hunt they only have so many bullets. Some have a rifle but if you didn't buy enough bullets you can't hunt."

And, of course, there's a dose of randomness to it, like surviving crossing a river. It's all up to the roll of the dice.

The traveling has begun. Good luck kids. You're going to need it.
