



Do You Want to Become a C.N.A.?

Labette Community College is now offering you an opportunity to become a C.N.A. with our "Nurse Aide: Geriatric" course.

- Locations: **Lecture:** Cherokee Center, south of Pittsburg, east of the junction of Hwy 400/Hwy 69
Clinicals: Medicalodges Frontenac, 206 S. Dittman, Frontenac
Both lecture and clinicals are from 5:00-9:15pm on Tuesdays and Thursdays
- When: Tuesday, January 17 through Tuesday, April 18, 2017
- Limit: 10 students - **Enrollment is on a first-come, first-serve basis when pre-enrollment test requirements are completed - no places will be held.**
- Instructor: Barbara Tavernaro, R.N.
- Cost (In-state): \$552 (6 credit hours) plus \$16 liability insurance fee and \$60 Cherokee Center site fee = **\$628***
- payment arrangements must be made within the first week of class

Cost (AR, OK, MO): \$678 (6 credit hours) plus \$16 liability insurance fee and \$60 Cherokee Center site fee = **\$754***
- payment arrangements must be made within the first week of class

- **Required** textbook is available as a rental from the LCC Bookstore or Cherokee Center for approximately \$30; call 620-820-1165 for information ~ textbook must be returned to bookstore by date of state test or student won't be allowed to test
- **Scrubs are required to be worn at clinicals**
- Pre-enrollment Tests: Two-step TB skin test **and** Accuplacer English (min score 54) or Compass reading (min score 60) or ACT reading (min score 13)

***Additional costs:**

1. All students must bring **\$25 cash** to the orientation to pay for the C.N.A. state certification and the processing fee.
2. All students must bring **\$38 cash** (or money order made out to LCC— NO checks) to the test site to pay for the state test. Students who fail to bring payment will not be allowed to take the test and will have to reschedule (and pay an additional \$20 to the Kansas Department for Aging & Disability Services.)

*Labette County Seniors (60 & over), employees of those with CTE agreements (city, county, and state) and LCC employees may take CREDIT courses and pay only material fees and textbook fees! This does not apply toward NON-CREDIT Workshops.
