Must present photo ID in order to test; ID must have clear photo of student and list first and last name. Acceptable IDs are driver's license, student ID (LCC or other institution), state ID or passport. Bring this sheet with you so that you can show which tests you need to take; must also know your Social Security number.

TWO-STEP TB SKIN TEST

The TB skin test is usually done on your inner arm. A small needle is used to put some testing material, called tuberculin, under your skin. In 48 to 72 hours after the test is "planted," a healthcare professional will need to read the test by checking your arm to see if there is a reaction to the test. The two-step test means you need to repeat this process within one to three weeks – **in other words you will be tested on both arms.**

You must receive "negative" results on both tests. Copies of the results should be brought to the campus (room M204) or **faxed to 620-421-4481, attn: Carol** (we must have them in order to enroll you; tests done within the last 12 months will be accepted.)
