FAFSA

1.



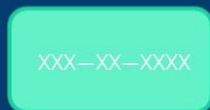
Your name, date of birth, phone number,
mailing address, and email address

2.



Your driver's license (if you have one)

3.



Your social security number, or your alien
registration number (if you're not a U.S. citizen)

4.



Your **2017** federal tax information or tax return including W-2
information (try to IRS Retrieval Tool to speed up your application)

5.



Records of untaxed income, such as child support,
interest income, and veteran's benefits

6.



Records of cash, savings, and checking
account balances

7.



Investments, including stocks, bonds, and real
estate (not the home in which you live)

8.



Any business and farm assets

9.



Before you begin the FAFSA you will need to create a FSA
ID. Your FSA ID acts as your signature for the FAFSA. Do
not share your ID with anyone.

10.



You're now ready to complete your FAFSA!
Remember, the aid process is competitive and it pays to
submit your FAFSA as early as possible.
