Subject: Graphic Design – Yearbook

Grade: High School

Description of Essential Standard to be Learned

- 1. Students will compare the advantages and disadvantages of working independently and working for others within the field (including mass production vs. custom work).
- 2. Students will demonstrate the methods used to create a visual representation of ideas and messages (i.e. combining words, symbols and/or images).
- 3. Students will identify the basics of composition.
- 4. Students will analyze the effects of the design elements (e.g. optical illusion and color theory).
- 5. Students will analyze legal concerns that affect the design field such as copyright and trademark issues.
- 6. Students will evaluate the visual appeal of graphic designs within visual communications.
- 7. Students will analyze the design process of graphic projects (from concept to finished product).
- 8. Students will demonstrate design principles in a graphic design project.
- 9. Students will demonstrate proper use of tools, software and equipment.
- 10. Students will create a portfolio of graphic design projects. (The finished yearbook)
